## Here are some questions you might ask about AFTV...

Q: What are the available **positions** in AFTV?

A: We offer seven job positions, you may apply to more than one position. Here are the seven different positions available:

- **Actor** - Basic in-front of camera acting for skits/features.
- **Cinematographer** - Basic director of camera positions, movements, etc.
- **Camera/Boom Operator** - Operating camera movements/holding boom microphone above the scene. (Hands-On)
- **Editor** - Video editing, input on ideas, etc.
- **Sketcher** - Skit writer, usually involves a group of people.
- **Makeup/Attire Design** - Makeup/attire designer for actors. Evidence of skill for Makeup.
- **Set Design** - In charge of setting the scene, coordinates with Cinematographer.

Q: When does AFTV have **meetings**?

A: AFTV will commonly happen on afternoons, hours and times range. All members will be notified of the next meeting three days in advance.

Q: **Where** does the filming, editing, etc., take place?

A: AFTV will have a dedicated space soon. No location is currently known.

Q: How will AFTV's videos and photos be **featured**?

A: Currently, AFTV will occur every month in homeroom, though it has a chance to change in the future. AFTV will have their own YouTube channel and social media sites.

Q: How many **applicants** will successfully enter the program?

A: There is no current maximum number of people we can allow to enter the program. Currently we will interview, and get to know our possible future members. Good evidence of attributes that can provide an asset to the program will provide a booster for an applicant!

Q: Is this program **strict**?

A: Yes, the program is quite strict on rules and terms. We want to make sure it is safe for our members and fellow students. As long as a member follows rules and contributes to the program, he/she will succeed within the program.

Q: How much **freedom** can a member have within the program?

A: We want all of our members to express their ideas within the program. As long as the member follows all **Terms and Conditions**/rules(Page 3), the member will have that freedom.

Q: Will the program be **supervised** by adults?

A: Yes, generally the program is a club/class, which requires an adult supervisor, unless the program is facing difficulties, and meets for emergency reasons. Trusted administration will provide restrictions and carry out **Terms and Conditions**(Page 3).

# AFTV Interests?

**\*Terms and Conditions** regarding Apex Friendship High School's AFTV program.

Please note, that once signing this application and turning it in, AFTV has the authority to conduct a **background check** on the student who is applying.

This application should only be filled out by the applicant, exception of the applicant's parent/guardian.

If the student who agrees to these terms and conditions and violates these terms and conditions can, and will be dismissed from the program.

Signature: If the signature is **forged**, this application will be placed as invalid. Also, the student will be banned from entering the program for 1 year.

When signing the optional **photo/video consent**, please note that when signing that section, the applicant agrees to be seen in videos/photos throughout the program. If the applicant/legal parent/guardian does not apply a signature to the section, the applicant will not be able to be in front of the camera. If applicant appears on photo/video, that footage will not be used.

**Rules & Consequences:** If the student violates any of these following rules while in the program, the student will face **consequences** towards their actions.

- 1. If the applicant breaks or damages any equipment provided by a fellow classmate within the program, school/county, or supervisors, the applicant has full responsibility in replacing that/those item(s). If the applicant fails to replace the items, AFTV's/AFHS's admin. will determine the degree of the misconduct, and determine the consequence.**
- 2. If the applicant within the program harasses, bullies, or injures(purposefully) his fellow classmate/supervisor within the program he/she will face possible consequences determined by AFTV's/AFHS's admin.**
- 3. If applicant displays excessive and unruly behavior towards AFTV, other classmates within the program, or the supervisor, the applicant will face possible consequences determined by AFTV's/AFHS's admin.**
- 4. If an applicant creates disturbance of classmates, the program(AFTV), or supervisors, the student will face consequences, depending on the degree AFTV's/AFHS's admin. decree.**
- 5. Attendance is required, the applicant must notify the director/coordinator before absence. If extensive absences occur, AFTV's/AFHS's admin. will determine the consequence.**
- 6. Applicant needs to demonstrate a good work ethic. If applicant fails to do so, possible consequences will be determined by AFTV's/AFHS's admin.**
- 7. AFTV must keep school appropriate conduct, and still follow the same rules Apex Friendship High School regulates. If applicant fails to do so, AFTV's/AFHS's admin. will determine the consequences.**

**If applicant breaks any of the above rules, the applicant can appeal towards their consequences.**

**All misconduct will be reported to Apex Friendship High's administration.**

(AFTV - Apex Friendship Television.) (AFHS - Apex Friendship High School.)

AFTV is a student run program, with teacher advisors who will supervise meetings.

No misconduct will be tolerated in this program and all rules must always be at play.
